Criterion #1	Holder of nationality of the participating team
Criterion #2	Holder of active WT Global Athlete License (GAL)
Criterion #3	Holder of the Kukkiwon Dan Certificate
Criterion #4*	Gyorugi athlete age of at least 17 (DOB Before December 31, 2008)
Criterion #5*	Recognized Poomsae athlete aged between 18 – 30 (1995 – 2007)
Criterion #6*	Freestyle Poomsae athlete age of at least 18 (DOB Before December 31, 2007)

\* The age limit for all division is based on the year, not on the date, when the Championships are held.

**10. COMPETITION RULES & METHODS (여기서부터 봄)**

**A. Senior Kyorugi**

- i. WT Competition Rules & Interpretation as of September 30, 2024 **shall apply**.
- ii. Single elimination system
- iii. Best of Three (3) System : 2 minutes x 3(2) round with 1 minute break
- iv. Grade: G-1
- v. Number of Courts: three (3)
- vi. Number of athletes: Open to all, no limit on number of athletes

**B. Poomsae**

- i. WT Poomsae Competition Rules & Interpretation as of September 30, 2024 **shall apply.**
- ii. Single elimination system for Individual Poomsae
- iii. Cut-off system for Freestyle Poomsae
- iv. Recognized Poomsae : Individual, Pair, and Team competitions up to 90 seconds with 30 seconds break between
- v. Freestyle Poomsae : Competitions from 90 seconds to 100 seconds
  1. Performed techniques must be within boundary of Taekwondo.
  2. Participating athletes must submit 1) Performance Plan and 2) USB with **music on it.**
  3. Music must be without lyrics and it should NOT contain any political, social, religious, and any contents that may harm, discriminate or offend others.
  4. Music must be non-copyrighted or music with consent from the creator/copyright holder

**11. WT GLOBAL LICENCE & ONLINE REGISTRATION**

- i. WT Global Licence Registration  
All athletes and team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete Licence (GAL) or Global Official Licence (GOL).
- ii. WT Online Registration  
Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global Licence.

**12. ENTRY FEES**

The entry fees from the participating athletes are collected onsite with US Dollar. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee.

**Note: Additional athletes will not be accepted at the registration center. Only athletes who have registered online and completed payment at the registration center will be allowed to compete.**

**REGULAR ENTRY FEES:** The national teams completing their registration during this period will be charged the regular registration fee.

- US \$25 per person (Each category of competition)
- Registration will begin on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 01:00, KST.
- Registration will end on June 15<sup>th</sup>, 18:00, KST.
- **Any WT Global Licence registration completed onsite will be charged a US\$50 onsite processing fee for each WT Global Licence required.**

**13. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS**

Medals will be awarded to the top three athletes in the respective weight category of the pertinent competition:

<b>1<sup>st</sup> PLACE:</b>	GOLD MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> PLACE:</b>	SILVER MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> PLACES:</b>	BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE

All athletes will get ranking point. The points will be reflected on WT World Ranking and WT Olympic Ranking. The ranking points per winners of the competition shall be allocated as follows.

#### **14. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO COMPETITION UNIFORM AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**

##### **A. KYORUGI**

- i. **KPNP Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear** will be used for the competition.
- ii. Participating contestants are required to wear **WT-recognized Kyorugi competition uniform** and WT-recognized protective equipment. **Wearing Dobok is not permitted.** The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT (<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html>).
- iii. The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthguard, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- iv. Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their competition uniform and protective equipment. **Any contestant who wears unofficial competition uniform or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.**
- v. The top has to cover completely the buttocks. However, the bottom of top should be more than 15cm above the knee cap
- vi. Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used.

##### **B. POOMSAE**

- i. Participating contestants must wear the WT-recognized Poomsae Competition uniform. Any contestants who do not wear WT-approved competition uniform will not be permitted to compete. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT (<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org>).
- ii. Standardization for Poomsae Competition Uniform : The mandatory Poomsae competition uniform is shown below:
- iii. Senior Division : White top with dark blue pants for male; white top with light blue pants



#### **15. IDENTIFICATION OF MANUFACTURER**

##### **A. KYORUGI**

- i. Manufacturer's identifications (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one for the top of Kyorugi competition uniform within 30cm<sup>2</sup> and between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the left arm, one for bottoms of Kyorugi competition uniform or within 30cm<sup>2</sup> located above the knee and center of the right leg, and one for Kyorugi belt within 6cm<sup>2</sup> at the end of the belt.

##### **B. POOMSAE**

- i. The number of manufacturer's identification (Name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be one(1) per garment within 20cm<sup>2</sup> except at the location of the WT logo according to the related WT guidelines in force as of this event.

**16. SPONSOR'S IDENTIFICATION**

- i. **Only ONE** sponsor's identification (logo) is allowed **on** each of Kyorugi competition uniform's top and **bottom**.
- ii. The sponsor's identification **must not exceed 50cm<sup>2</sup> and must not be placed in the areas designated for the WT logo**, manufacturer's identification, national flag, and NOC code.

**17. MEDICAL CONTROL**

- i. The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and, where necessary, the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competition.
- ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests may be conducted **on other athletes**. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the championships.
- iii. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)  
Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit **a TUE application via ADAMS, along** with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact [tue@ita.sport](mailto:tue@ita.sport) **to have one created**.

Alternatively, please download the TUE Application Form. Once duly completed and signed, send it with the required medical documents to [tue@ita.sport](mailto:tue@ita.sport) with a copy to [antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org](mailto:antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org) by at least 30 days **before the first day of competition**.

**18. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS SESSION**

- i. **The Head of Team Meeting** shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the competition - July 4<sup>th</sup> for Kyorugi and July 7<sup>th</sup> for Poomsae discipline - in the presence of the WT officials and the representatives of the participating teams.
- ii. At least one representative from each team must attend the **Head of Team Meeting**. In case no representative **can attend** the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform **the** Technical Delegate or WT Sport & Event Management department before the meeting.

**19. WEIGH-IN**

- i. General weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category **competition**.
- ii. Random weigh-in of the contestants shall take place in the morning on the competition day of their respective weight category except M+87 & W+73. All contestants in draw must be presented.
- iii. Random weigh-in shall apply to following number of contestants **per weight category** with 5% allowance as the table below.

- iv. During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in nude if they wish to do so.

## **20. INDEMNITIES**

- i. The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are **covered by valid travel & medical insurance**.
- ii. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

## **21. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION**

### **ACCOMMODATION**

Teams are responsible for arranging their own accommodation and meals. Please refer to the OC website (<https://www.wu-tf.com>) for accommodation information.

### **TRANSPORTATION**

Transportation services **will be available only within Daegu City, Korea**, with support limited to arrivals at Daegu International Airport, Dongdaegu Express Bus Terminal, and Dongdaegu or Seodaegu High-speed Railway Stations. When submitting your participation application through the Organizing Committee's website, kindly specify your arrival time in Daegu City or alternatively, contact our committee representative via the provided telephone number.

All coaches are required to hold a WT Coach Certificate Level (1). **Coaches without a valid Level I certificate will be removed from the registration and will not allowed to coach at the Championships**

All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as a tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short sleeved), and trousers, and sport shoes during Semi-Finals and Finals. **Caps or hats are strictly prohibited**. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to **coach during the** the event.
