Team event : One-by-One performance

- 2) Non-official uniforms are permitted
- 3) Competition Rules : World Taekwondo competition rules shall apply, effective September 30, 2024
- 4) 4 athletes enter simultaneously → Perform 2 poomsae → Final rankings are determined**
- 5) Methods of Scoring
 - Composition of refereeing official shall be a five-judge system.
 - Final score shall be the average point of the total points summed up except the highest and lowest points scored by five-judges.
 - In case of a tied score, the winner shall be the one who has scored higher points in order of Presentation, and total points.
(total points of all judges including highest and lowest points).
 - If it is still tied in Presentation, and total points, then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner.
- 7) Others

C. Correction Period : 2026. 6. 24. (Wed) 23:59 (Korean standard time)

※ **All participants must verify athlete information, competition division, and any omissions within the correction period. After the correction period, no modifications will be permitted, and the Organizing Committee shall not be responsible for any issues arising from failure to verify the information.**

※ **Coaching staff must also complete participation registration.**

※ **Foreign residents living in Korea must apply for participation and pay the entry fee in the same manner as Korean participants.**

Entry Fee

A. Koreans

- KRW 30,000 for individual (one category per person).

- KRW 60,000 per team in pair of recognized poomsae.

- KRW 90,000 per team in team match of recognized poomsae.

※ **The participation fee must be paid within 7 days after registration.**

B. Foreigners

- \$25 for individual (one category per person).

- \$50 per team in pair of recognized poomsae.

- \$75 per team in team match of recognized poomsae.

※ **Coaching staff are exempt from participation fees.**

※ **Cash payment at on-site registration center (card are not accepted).**

※ **Payment must be made in US dollars (\$) only (KRW and EUR not accepted).**

※ **Domestic participants and foreign residents in Korea must pay via bank transfer.**

However, foreign participants are required to make the on-site payments.

※ **No refunds will be issued after June 25th, regardless of participation.**

C. Teams participating in the Division event may register until 08:30 on July 5 (Sun).

※ **AD cards and participation certificates will be issued to participants and executives during the registration period.**

Head of Team Meeting (Online)

- A. Date : 2026. 6. 30.(Tue) 11:00 (Division 2 & 3)
- B. Place : Online(Zoom) Head of Team Meeting / The meeting link will be announced later.
- C. A representative of each team must attend the Head of Team Meeting, and teams that fail to attend will not be permitted to raise any objections.

Supporting Facilities

- A. Provision of Transportation (Overseas Athletes and Officials)
 - Bus service (Daegu International Airport, Dongdaegu express bus terminal, and Dongdaegu or Seodaegu high-speed railway station ~ Stadium)
 - Other arrival locations must be arranged in advance with the Organizing Committee.
 - Pickup service will be provided according to the arrival time only for teams that notify the Organizing Committee of their arrival time in Daegu in advance.
 - Teams that do not notify their arrival time in advance must use the shuttle buses operating at the regular schedule.
- B. Shuttle service will be provided from accommodations to the stadium .
(shuttle buses will operate during the competition)
 - ※ **However, participants traveling through travel agencies or from other regions are excluded.**
 - ※ **After completing the online registration, please fill in the bus and train schedule form (arrival time at pickup location) provided by the OC and submit it to 2025.wutf@gmail.com by June 24th.**
 - ※ **The shuttle bus schedule and boarding locations will be announced later on the Organizing Committee's website.**

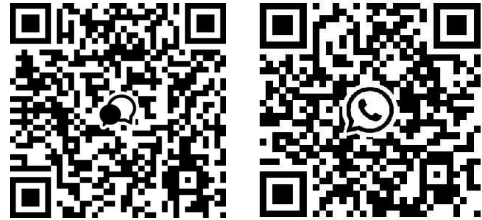
NOTICE
