#### B. Recognized Poomsae

- 1) Methods of Competition: Elimination tournament System
- 2) Competition Area: 10m x 10m
- 3) Athletes are required to wear WT or KTA poomsae uniform
- 4) Competition Rules: In Force as of September 30, 2024
- 5) Methods of Scoring
- Composition of refereeing official shall be a five-judge system.
- Final score shall be the average point of the total points summed up except the highest and lowest points scored by five-judges.
- In case of a tied score, the winner shall be the one who has scored higher points in order of Presentation, and total points (total points of all judges including highest and lowest points).
- If it is still tied in Presentation, and total points, then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner.

#### 6) Others

- The regulation articles above are subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- If the competitor is called three (3) times thirty (30) minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee.

- B. Adult division: Born on or Before December 31, 2007
- C. Middle division: 2008. 1. 1. ~ 2011. 12. 31.
- D. Elementary division: 2012. 1. 1. ~ 2017. 12. 31.
- E. Kindergarten division: Born on or Before December 31, 2018
- F. Number of Participants: Limited to 700
- **\*\*** (COMMON) The age limits for each category are based on the year of competition.

#### □ Participation Fee

#### A. Koreans

- KRW 30,000 for individual (one category per person)
- KRW 60,000 per team in pair of recognized poomsae
- KRW 90,000 per team in team match of recognized poomsae
- **\*\*** The participation fee must be paid within 7 days after registration.

#### **B.** Foreigners

- \$25 for individual (one category per person)
- \$50 per team in pair of recognized poomsae
- \$75 per team in team match of recognized poomsae
- **\*\*** Cash payment at on-site registration center (card is not acceptable).
- **\* Coaching staff are exempt from participation fees.**
